بسم الله الرحمن الرحيم

اللَّهُمَّ يَا ذَا الْمَنِّ لَا يُمْنُ عَلَيْكَ يَا ذَا الْجَلَالِ وَالْإِكْرَامِ * يَا ذَا الطَّلُولِ وَالْإِنْعَامِ *

Allah, bestower of favors (no one bestows favors on You!), full of majesty and glory, resplendent with magnanimity and benefaction

لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا أَنْتَ يَا ظَهَرَ اللَّاحِظِينَ * وَيَا جَارَ الْمُسْتَغِيثِينَ * وَيَا صَرِيخَ الْمُسْتَصْرِخِينَ *
وَيَا مُجِيبَ دَعْوَةِ الْمُضْطَرِّينَ *

There is no God but You. O Support for seekers of sanctuary!
O Haven for seekers of refuge! O protector of those who scream for help! O He answerer of the prayer of the helpless!

وَيَا نَاصِرَ الْمَظْلُومِينَ * وَيَا غِيَاثَ الْمُسْتَغِيثِينَ * وَيَا أَرْحَمَ الرَّاحِمِينَ *

O helper of the oppressed! O Succour for those who seek aid!
O most merciful of the merciful!

إِلَهِي إِنْ كُنْتَ كَتَبْتَنِي فِي أُمِّ الْكِتَابِ عِنْدَكَ شَقِيئاً فَقِيراً فَامْحُ عَنِّي اسْمَ الْفَقْرِ وَالشَّقَاوَةِ *

Allah, if you have written me down in the Mother of the Book that is with you as a wretch and destitute, erase from me the label of destitution and wretchedness.

وَأَثْبِتْنِي عِنْدَكَ سَعِيداً غَنِيّاً *

And confirm/establish me instead as blissful and wealthy.

وَإِنْ كُنْتَ كَتَبْتَنِي فِي أُمِّ الْكِتَابِ عِنْدَكَ مَحْرُوماً مُقْتَرّاً عَلَيَّ رِزْقِي * فَامْحُ عَنِّي حِرْمَانِي وَتَقْتِيرَ رِزْقِي *

Allah, if you have written me down in the Mother of the Book that is with you as deprived, one whose sustenance is scanty, erase my deprivation and the scantiness of my sustenance.

فَإِنَّكَ قُلْتَ فِي كِتَابِكَ الْكَرِيمِ الْمُنَزَّلِ عَلَى نَبِيِّكَ مُحَمَّدٍ صَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَآلِهِ *

For you have said in your Noble Book, that has been revealed to your Prophet Muhammad, Allah's blessings on him and his progeny—

"يَمْحُو اللَّهُ مَا يَشَاءُ وَيُثَبِّتُ وَعِنْدَهُ أُمُّ الْكِتَابِ" *

“Allah erases what he wills, and confirms what he wills, for the Mother of the Book is with him” (Quran, Ra’d: 39).

وَقُلْتَ وَأَنْتَ أَصْدَقُ الْقَائِلِينَ * "وَسِعَتْ رَحْمَتِي كُلَّ شَيْءٍ"

You have also said—and you are the most truthful of speakers— ‘My mercy encompasses all things’ (modified from Quran, A’raf:156).
